Community Memorial Hospital – Ventura is a 6-story, state-of-the-art hospital. Equipped with advanced technology and staffed by experts at every level, Community Memorial boasts an exceptional reputation for quality. Kaiser Permanente patients can take advantage of several key services provided by the Ventura hospital.

Heart & Vascular

Community Memorial provides more cardiovascular care to the people of Ventura County than any other local medical facility. Their comprehensive program covers Structural Heart, Cardiothoracic Surgery, Vascular Surgery, and Cardiac Rehabilitation. The Cath Lab is equipped with advanced imaging technologies to facilitate delicate, catheter-based procedures. The hospital is a certified, award-winning Primary Stroke Center and a STEMI Receiving Center for heart attack care, certified by the American Heart Association.

The heart and vascular team is on call
24 hours a day, 7 days a week.



Every type of surgery — open, laparoscopic, and robot-assisted procedures — is currently available at Community Memorial. The hospital has 10 state-of-the-art surgical suites, including dedicated rooms for robotic-assisted surgery, cardiac, neuro, and spine procedures. Renowned for its expertise in robotic surgery, the hospital offers the da Vinci® Surgical System for general and gynecological procedures, the ROSA® Robotic Total Knee & Hip Replacement System, and the Globus ExcelsiusGPS™, specifically designed to operate on the spine.

Labor & Delivery

As Ventura County's premier destination for labor and delivery, Community Memorial Hospital – Ventura is a designated "Baby-Friendly Facility." This recognizes that the hospital meets the highest standards for breastfeeding education and support. The maternity wing features 11 spacious private birthing suites with private showers. Obstetricians, midwives, anesthesiologists, and specialized nurses are on staff around the clock.

The hospital's Level III Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) provides a high level of specialized care for fragile newborns. A neonatologist is available 24/7.
