Thanks to generous contributions from our community, donations received totaled \$1,352,780 — a record high — and we're putting every dollar to good use.

The hospital replaced essential equipment & acquired vital new technologies.

Medical equipment needs replacing and upgrading over time. Some donations covered basics like gurneys, stretchers & wheeled walkers, while other donations covered large capital needs that have made a difference throughout the hospital:

- The Cath Lab has a new Hemodynamic System to monitor patients during procedures
- The NICU has a new OmniBed Carestation that keeps infants safe & warm
- The Imaging Department has new portable Ultrasound machines for rapid bedside imaging
- Care teams across the organization are using new AccuVein® vein finding devices

From powerful new imaging technologies to high-tech cribettes for our littlest patients, our donors take care of our hospital so we can take care of our community.

In 2023, Community Memorial Foundation purchased \$1,076,751 in vital equipment.

Read below to learn about some of the ways we put your dollars to work.



Hemodynamic System

This state-of-the-art system monitors blood pressure, pressure inside the heart and arteries, blood oxygen levels, and more.



Portable Ultrasounds

Portable ultrasound enables rapid imaging at the patient's bedside — especially useful in the Emergency Department.



AccuVein® Vein Finding Device

This device enables clinicians to rapidly identify optimal vein targets for IV placement.



OmniBed Carestation

An incubator and radiant warmer in one, the OmniBed Carestation keeps our tiny NICU patients warm and cozy.



Hospital Gurneys & Stretchers

Foundation dollars help us replace basic essential equipment such as our gurneys, stretchers, and wheeled walkers.



Laboratory Equipment (Sterile Tubing Welder)

In the lab's welding process for pharmaceutical tubing, this device minimizes the risk of contamination of specimens.


